#### Meeting of December 12, 2016

At the special meeting the Board of Education certified the mill levies for 2017 as follows: General Fund tax levy is 29.022 mills, Bond Redemption is 10.426, for total mills of 39.448. The General Fund Mill Levy would have been 102.995 if there had been no state revenues estimated to be received during 2017.

#### Good News Reports

Informational reports on curriculum and assessments were presented by Curriculum Director Shelley David and District Assessment Coordinator, Brian Haddican. Ms. David's report included a review of curriculum currently in use; Mr. Haddican reviewed PSAT assessment scores.

#### **Employment**

Board approval was given for the following employment items: teaching contracts for Nancy Duran, Elementary Teacher and Kim Cranson, Secondary Teacher, and employment of Substitute Teachers David Hirsch and John Lomasney and Substitute Custodian Edgar Gonzales.

#### **Board Policy Revisions**

Revisions to policies DH Bonded Employees/Officers, GBGE Staff Maternity/Paternity/Parental Leave and JH Student Absences and Excuses were approved for second reading and adoption. Policies IKF and IKF-2 Graduation Requirements were reviewed on first reading; work will be ongoing on establishing graduation guidelines, and will be considered for approval at a future meeting.

#### Other Items

The board also approved minutes of previous meetings, financial reports for October and November and one requisition in the amount of \$23,328.80 to Trinidad State Junior College for concurrent student enrollment.
